UF3 The capital of Western Australia situated on the Swan River 15km NE of Fremantle. A second post office for the Swan River Colony was established at Perth with the appointment of James Purkis on 4 May 1830. Purkis had conducted a branch Post Office in London and was probably the only person in the new colony with post office experience. He resigned a year later and Tom Blakey, the Government Messenger, was appointed on 26 June 1831. Blakey resigned on 17 February 1832. Charles Macfaull, operating from Fremantle, apparently had an agent in Perth between March and November 1832 when he himself moved to Perth. Following Macfaull's resignation on 9 March 1840, Captain Edward Picking was appointed to the position which was upgraded to Postmaster General in June 1841.

Telegraphic communication between Perth and Fremantle was established by private capital on 21 June 1869. The government became involved later and Perth Post Office effectively became a Post and Telegraph Office from 1 March 1871 when the government assumed responsibility for the lines and staffing. The whole undertaking was purchased by the Government on 1 January 1873.

The first cover to be recorded from Mourambine came to light in June 1991. The stamps are struck with a 12 bar numeral obliterator of which the first digit is indecipherable and the second is not much better but appears to be a zero. The practical possibilities are 12-10 or 12-20. (*Black Swan*, June 1991).

Pingelly replaced Mourambine in October 1889 but there may have been some operational overlap as Mourambine's obliterator was NOT used by Pingelly on a letter in mid-December 1889. The new Railway Stationmaster, Mr Ball, was also the first Postmaster and he used the new Pingelly cds to cancel the stamp. The Post Office apparently remained in the Railway Station until the new P&TO was opened on 1 August 1893. The next recorded item from Pingelly is dated only five weeks later, on 6-09-93, and bears a 13 bar dumb obliterator suggesting that the obliterator was issued for the change to P&TO status. (See Roebourne). This in turn suggests that, for the period October 1889 to July 1893 while the PO was in the Railway Station, an obliterator was not in use.

RE1 Port for whaling, lead export and general cargo 75NNW Geraldton. A Ticket of Leave Depot and Pensioner Guard Village were established at nearby Lynton in May 1853 to facilitate the operation of the Geraldine Mine. A postal salary of £5 is shown for 1853 but it appears that nothing formal was done before 1 March 1854 when Mr Briggs was appointed PM. 2400 1d stamps were sent to Port Gregory from Perth on 30-06-54. At that time Port Gregory was considered the principal port for the district. Champion Bay however, became dominant and, following the withdrawal of the Pensioner Guards in January 1858, Port Gregory declined in importance. A postal salary was paid for another four years but postal business was minimal.
