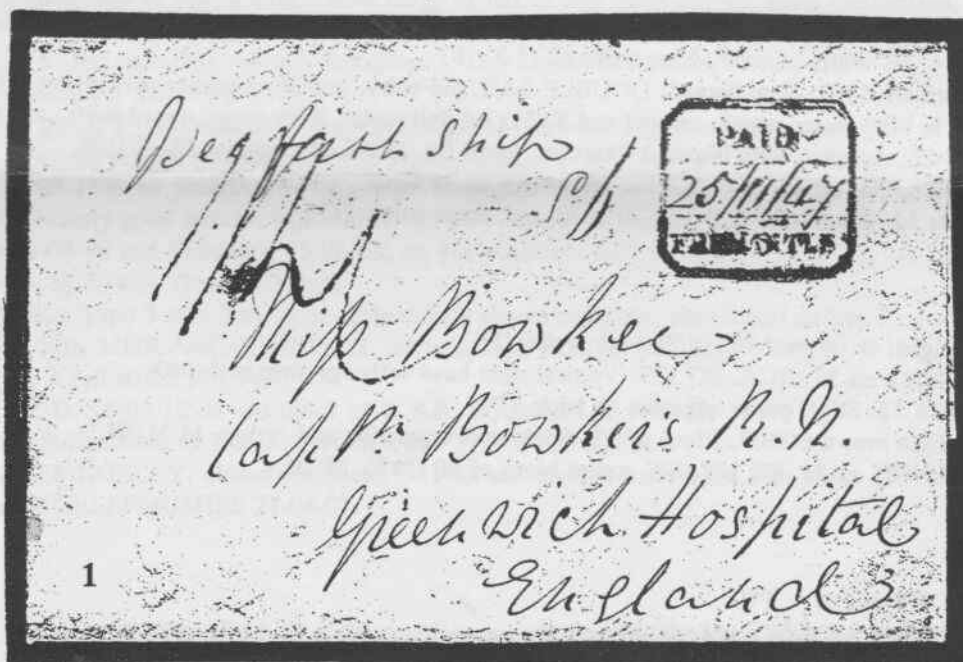

(4) Purchasers may reject any lot that is not as described in the catalogue provided the lot is returned to the Western Australia Study Group within 10 days of posting for purchasers within Australia and within 30 days for overseas purchasers. (5) Every effort is made to ensure that descriptions are accurate but neither the Western Australia Study Group nor its officers or agents accept any responsibility in respect of the accuracy of the descriptions or valuations in the catalogue. (6) Vendors will be charged a commission of 10% (members of WASG) or 15% (non-members WASG). There is no buyer's commission. (7) **POSTING.** All purchases will be sent First Class Air Mail UNLESS OTHERWISE ADVISED WHEN BIDDING.
